Creativity, activity, service (CAS) helps students to develop their own identities in accordance with the ethical principles embodied in the IB mission statement and the IB learner profile.



CURRICULUM COMPONENTS

DP students must choose one course from each of five subject groups delivering a breadth of knowledge and understanding in:

Language and literature
Second language
Individuals and societies
Sciences
Mathematics

Furthermore, students must also choose either an arts course from the arts group or a second course from one of the other groups.
